CONDITIONS – please read carefully prior to signing.

1. PAYMENT OF LESSONS:
 - a. All lessons billed by the College are done per semester on the school fees
 - b. Lessons are billed at a rate of 18 lessons per semester
 - c. Failure to pay for lessons will result in termination of lessons and a new application form to be filled out prior to any recommencement of lessons
 - d. Fees for instrumental lessons are in line with recommended rates by the Music Teachers Association of Queensland
 - e. External instrumental tutors (including Piano & Guitar) that come into the College will bill separately and prices may differ slightly to those outlined above.
2. PAIRED LESSONS:
 - a. *Placement in a paired lesson is dependent on tutors, suitable paired partners and lesson time availability. As a result the placement in a paired lesson cannot be guaranteed.
 - b. Should a paired lesson not be available students will be automatically placed into a regular lesson schedule and the full regular schedule charged.
3. MISSED LESSONS
 - a. When a lesson cannot be attended due to illness notification must go to the Cultural Department Leader on (07) 5495 7370 prior to the lesson.
 - b. Make-up lessons due to illness will not be given unless 24 hours notice is given.
 - c. For a change of lesson time to accommodate school events (exams, excursions, sporting commitments) a minimum of 48 hours is required.
 - d. Lessons are only required to be made up when the instrumental tutor has been absent in which they will arrange a make up lesson
 - e. Any required refunds arising from this can be negotiated with the Cultural Department Leader in writing during term 4 prior to the conclusion of the school year
4. **CANCELLATION OF LESSONS**
 - a. Lessons are charged per semester and thus it is expected all students complete lessons for a full semester
 - b. If a lesson is to be cancelled a Cancellation of Instrumental Music Lesson Form must be completed and submitted to the Cultural Department Leader a minimum of 4 school weeks prior to the start of the next semester
 - c. Failure to give appropriate notification will result in the continued billing and may result in the withholding of credits.
5. EXPECTATIONS OF STUDENTS
 - a. All students taking private instrumental lessons at the College are expected to be involved in a minimum of one ensemble.
 - b. All vocal students are expected to be involved in College Voices (Choir)
 - c. Students practice for their instrumental lessons and ensembles
 - d. Students are prepared and punctual for all rehearsals and performances
6. INSTRUMENT HIRE**
 - a. The College cannot guarantee instrument hire through the College. Where the College cannot provide an instrument we recommend the *WoodsWind & Brass* or *OzWinds* rental service
 - b. If instrument hire through the college is required, an Instrument Hire form must be completed and submitted prior to the student being given an instrument
