SCHOOL FEES AT A GLANCE

St Columban's College strives to achieve affordable excellence in establishing its annual charges. The College charges include:

- Tuition Costs, including for Vocational (VET) Certificate Subjects,
- Curriculum Excursions, Incursions and Year Level Camps (where applicable)
- Provision of an electronic device to every student
- Participation in the Saturday Sporting Program (TAS Competition) and Co Curricular activities
- Highly resourced Wellbeing Centre including access to Counselling and Careers advice
- Participation in the College's Excellence Programs (subject to application and or audition as required)

FEES PRIOR TO ENROLMENT

At St Columban's College, there are one-off Application and Confirmation fees are charged prior to a student commencing.

Application Fee - \$120 (non-refundable)

This one-off fee covers the administration costs associated with processing applications for new enrolments, in addition to the pre-enrolment interview with parents and students. The fee is payable on submission of an enrolment application form to the College.

Confirmation Fee - \$300 (non-refundable)

This fee secures a student's place at the College and covers the administrative costs of enrolling the student into the College.

ANNUAL STATEMENT OF FEES AND LEVIES

The total amount of fees and levies that families are charged each year are comprised of the following:

- School Fees
- School Levies
- Capital levies
- Parents and Friends Levy (PEC)

College fees are payable within 28 days from the issue of Statement of fees and levies each year. If a payment plan is approved, it is an expectation that 25% of the annual fees and levies are paid each quarter and in full by the 31st of December.

School Fees

Cover all recurrent expenditure and course costs, including non-government funded staffing, administration costs, utilities, insurance and maintenance of College facilities. Sibling discounts on school fees are available for additional students in the immediate family (i.e. who reside under the same roof) who are enrolled at the College at any one time. The discount applied depends on the number of children in attendance on the same family account.

School Levies

School levies cover all direct costs associated with your student's subjects taught at the College and covers any certificate level subjects. It includes all year level and subject activities, curriculum-based excursions and incursions, year level camps (where applicable), a broad range of co-curricular offerings. It also includes the provision of an electronic device that is assigned to your student.

Capital Levy

This Levy assists the College in the refurbishment and development of existing College buildings and facilities.

Parent Engagement Committee Levy

This Levy assists the Parent and Community Engagement Committee (PEC) in supporting the College in a range of activities to ensure equitable distribution of resources for extracurricular programs and special events to enhance students experiences at the College. Contributions include supporting students who represent the Region/State in their chosen field of excellence, Arts and Cultural events, Academic, Sporting events, and contributions towards the College's capital works.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

Formal & Jersey Levy

The Formal and Jersey levy will be added to the family account for all students at the commencement of Year 12. If students wish to opt out of either the formal or receiving a Senior Jersey, they should notify the College by emailing the College at scaboolture@bne.catholic.edu.au before the published deadlines, and a credit will be applied to the account. Formal - In the instance that final numbers for the formal have been provided to the venue, parents will be unable to receive a credit for this charge.

METHOD OF PAYMENT

Our preferred method of payment of fees is by Direct Debit, Bpay, cash, or Bpoint (Credit Card). An approved payment plan can be organised by contacting the finance office on 54953 111 or SCBOFinance@bne.catholic.edu.au.

DISCOUNT

A 5% discount **on the school fee component of the annual statement of fees and levies only** is available to families where the full year's fees are received by the due date.

CANCELLATION OF ENROLMENT

4 weeks' notice needs to be provided to the College by completing the Departing Student Form accessible through the Parent Portal.

VOLUNTARY DONATIONS

St Columban's Bursary Fund (Administered by the Catholic Foundation) provides financial assistance through Scholarships/Bursaries to students who would not otherwise be able to afford to attend the College. The Bursary Fund is registered as a deductible gift recipient and any donation over \$2 received can be used as a tax deduction.
